providing quality education to the wards of army personnel at an affordable cost.

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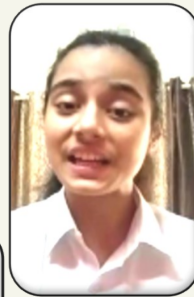
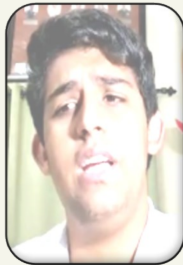

## CALLIGRAPHY COMPETITION

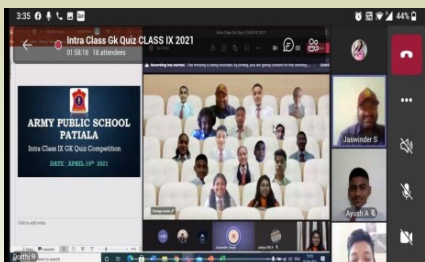

## GK QUIZ

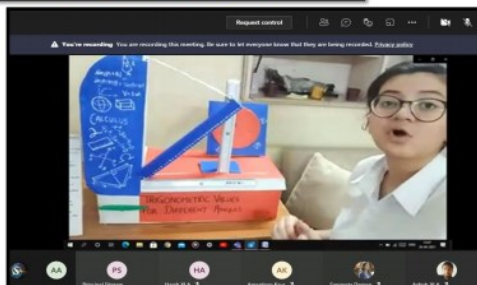

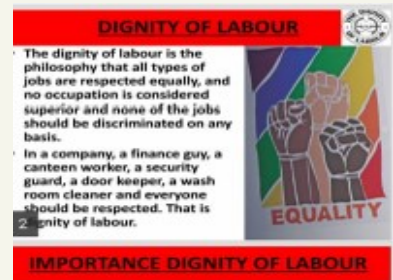


the school counsellor highlighted the importance of the day and the contribution of every section of

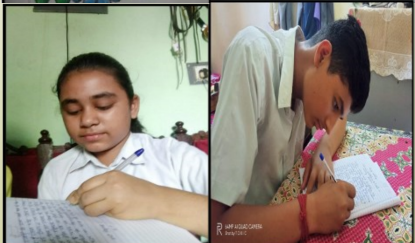
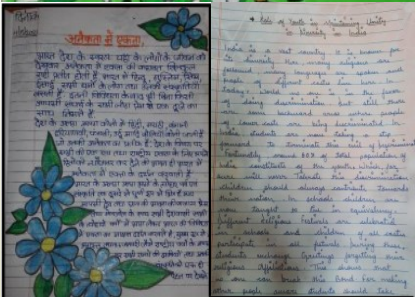
It is rightly said that a person's childhood often projects his future and the zealous participation of primary wing students in various online activities has made it very evident. Some of them were like

declamation contest and paying tribute to parents by making cards on Mother's and Father's day. All these activities gave us a peep into the talents galore.

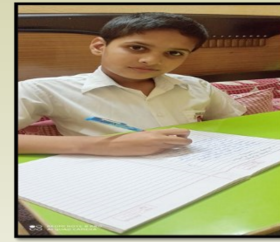


## EK BHARAT SHRESHTA BHARAT

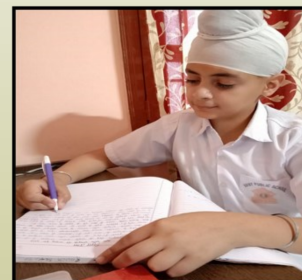
In class VIII English essay writing competition, the students who secured first position in their respective sections were Sagun (VIII A), RohitYadav(VIII B),

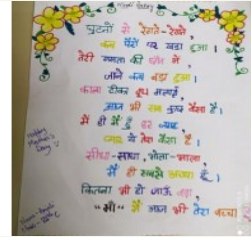
In class X, Harbaksha was adjudged the best for writing on the topic Role of Youth in maintaining Unity in Diversity of India.

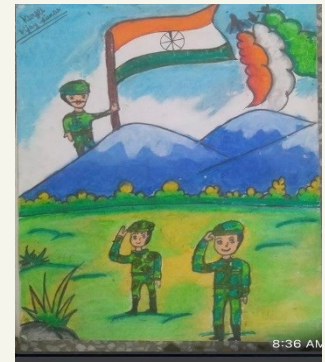
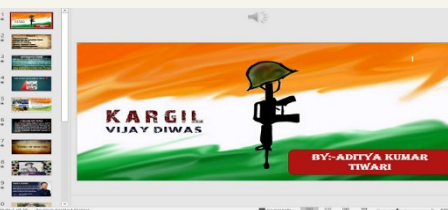
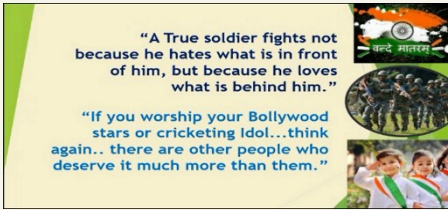
## TRIBUTE TO THE EPITOME OF LOVE

# ACADEMIC ACCOLADES

## CLASS XII LAURELS

In Class XII, 53 students out of 159 students secured 90% and above marks.

The topper of the school was Miss Anuradha Sharma of Commerce stream who secured 97.60% marks and the second highest scorer was Miss Monika of Humanities stream who scored 97.20% marks. In Science Non Medical stream, Master Prajyot Pandit Chakre topped the stream by securing 96.8% while Ms Jaspreet Kaur was the topper of Science Medical stream who secured 96% marks. The API of the school ascended to 323.4 from previously achieved 281. The API achieved by APS Patiala for the session 2020-21 has placed the school on the tenth position among the schools of Western Command.
